Dr. Dey received his doctorate in Statistics from Purdue University in 1980. He has been teaching at UConn since 1985. In 1997 he was named Head of the Statistics Department and continues to hold that position. Dr. Dey has received numerous research grants, including some funded by the National Science Foundation, the National Institute of Health and the National Institute of Mental Health, to name a few. In addition to acting as chair on several committees at the university, he acts as chair on numerous national and international committees. Dr. Dey has extensively published and has served on the editorial boards of several professional journals. His professional affiliations include fellowship in the American Statistical Association, Institute of Mathematical Statistics, and International Statistical Institute and membership in The International Biometrics Society, The Bernoulli Society for Mathematical Statistics and Probability, Calcutta Statistical Association, New York Academy of Sciences, and Visiting Faculty of the National Institute of Standards and Technology. A recipient of many honors and distinctions, Dr. Dey has most recently been elected chair of the Section on Bayesian Statistical Sciences to the American Statistical Association.
