

TRAVEL DIRECTIONS to CHCM and CHIP Offices (UConn, Storrs, CT)

1. Driving Directions to the University of Connecticut - South Parking Garage

Take I-84 to Exit 68 (Tolland). At the end of the exit ramp take 195 South. Travel 3-4 miles - cross Rte. 32 and then after another 2 miles - cross Rte. 44. Continue another mile or so to the Storrs campus. Take a right onto North Eagleville Road (large church on right). Turn left at second light onto Hillside Road. Turn right onto Stadium Road (between Gampel Pavilion and UConn Co-op). Proceed to the South Parking Garage entrance (on left behind building).

2. Alternate Route from Hartford and Points West

Take Rte 84E to Rte 384 to Rte 44 East. Continue on Rte 44 to intersection with Rte 195. Turn right onto Rte 195. Travel a mile or so to the UConn campus. Stay right and make a right onto North Eagleville Road (large church on corner). Turn left at second light onto Hillside Road. After third stop sign, turn right onto Stadium Road (between Gampel Pavilion and the UConn Co-op). Proceed to the South Parking Garage (entrance on left behind Co-op building).

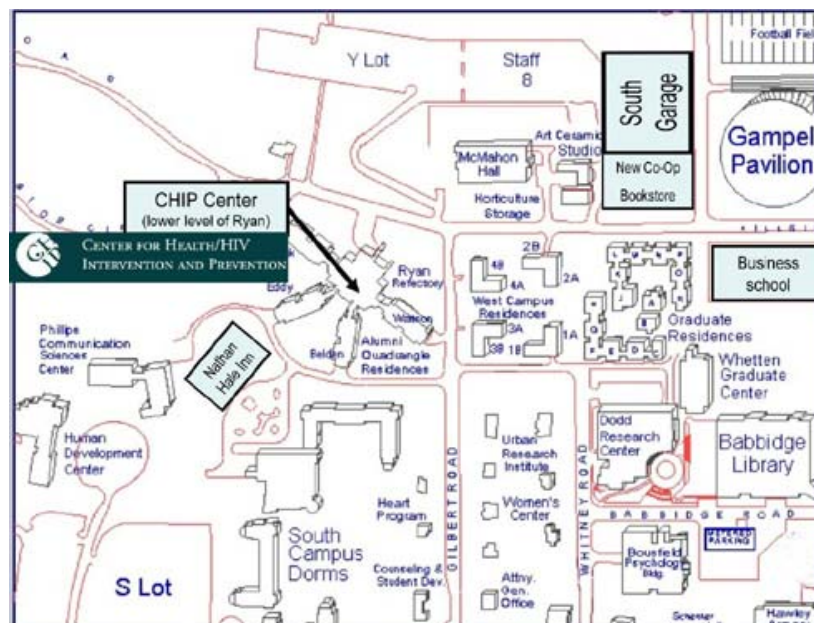
3. From Bradley Airport

Take I-91 south to Exit 35A (Manchester - Rte 291). At end of Rte 291 (about 5 miles), **exit left** onto I-84 East. *Follow directions in #1 above.*

-OR-

At end of 291, **exit right** to Rte 384 East. At end of Rte 384 take Rte 44 East..
Follow directions in #2 above.

Walking Directions from the South Parking Garage to the CHCM offices (CHCM and CHIP are located in the Ryan Refectory): Exit the South Parking Garage and walk to the front of the UConn Co-op. Take a right onto Hillside Road heading south. Walk to the first stop sign – intersection of Hillside Road and Gilbert Road. Kitty corner to your left is a group of dormitories (Alumni Quad). Enter into the quad via the diagonal pathway at the southeast corner of Hillside and Gilbert. The J. Ray Ryan Refectory will be on your right and Elmer S. Watson Hall on your left. Walk under the overpass between those buildings. Once through the overpass, at the intersection of sidewalks, turn right. The entrance to the Center for Health/HIV Intervention & Prevention (CHIP) is first door on your right.
